All submissions must be submitted electronically, in PDF format and uploaded on EDAS. The direct link for paper submission is <http://edas.info/N9001>. The submissions should be formatted with single-spaced, double-column pages using at least 10 pt (or higher) size fonts on A4 or letter pages in IEEE style format. The maximum page numbers are 6 for full papers. The camera-ready version for an accepted paper cannot exceed 6 pages. All Camera-Ready submissions must be submitted electronically, in PDF format and uploaded on EDAS. Please upload the camera-ready paper at EDAS by going to "My Papers" tab and clicking on the icon under the column "Upload" where the corresponding paper is located. The Camera-Ready submissions should be formatted with single-spaced, double-column pages using at least 10 pt (or higher) size fonts on A4 or letter pages in IEEE style format. The maximum page numbers are 6. The camera-ready version for an accepted paper cannot exceed 6 pages. The conference full registration justifies publication of one paper up to 6 pages. For more than 6 pages, there exists an extra fee for over-length paper charge: USD 50 per page.

All presenters must be at their posters at the specified times (see the Program page of ICOIN 2011). Posters must be removed immediately after the session ending time.
